A RESOLUTION OF THE DALLAS PARK CEMETERY DISTRICT ("DISTRICT") APPROVING THE EXEMPTION FROM AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the **Dallas Park Cemetery District** (the "District") wishes to claim exemption from the audit requirements of Section 29-1-603 CRS; and

WHEREAS, Section 29-1-604 CRS states that any local government where neither revenues nor expenditures exceed \$500,000 may, with the approval of the State Auditor, be exempt from the provisions of Section 29-1-603, CRS; and


WHEREAS, neither revenues nor expenditures for the District exceeded \$100,000 for Fiscal Year 2020; and

WHEREAS, an application for exemption from audit for the District has been prepared by Hannah Hollenbeck who has been duly appointed as the District Bookkeeper, in accordance with regulations issued by the State Auditor.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DISTRICT that the application for exemption from audit for the District for the Fiscal Year ended December 31, 2020, has been personally reviewed and is hereby approved by a majority of the Board of Directors of the District; that those members of the District have signified their approval by signing below; and that this Resolution shall be attached to, and become a part of, the Application for Exemption from Audit of the District for the Fiscal Year ended December 31, 2020.


