Policy - Requirements

The Office of the State Auditor Local Government Audit Division may accept an electronic submission of an application for exemption from audit that includes governing board signatures obtained through a program such as DocuSign or EchoSign. Required elements and safeguards are as follows:

- The preparer of the application is responsible for obtaining board signatures that comply with the requirement in Section 29-1-604 (3), C.R.S., that states the application shall be personally reviewed, approved, and signed by a majority of the members of the governing body.
- The application must be accompanied by the signature history document created by the electronic signature software. The signature history document must show when the document was created and when the document was emailed to the various parties, and include the dates the individual board members signed the document. The signature history must also show the individuals' email addresses and IP address.
- Office of the State Auditor staff will not coordinate obtaining signatures.

The application for exemption from audit form created by our office includes a section for governing body approval. Local governing boards note their approval and submit the application through one of the following three methods:

- 1) Submit the application in hard copy via the US Mail including original signatures.
- 2) Submit the application electronically via email and either,
 - a. Include a copy of an adopted resolution that documents formal approval by the Board, or
 - b. Include electronic signatures obtained through a software program such as DocuSign or EchoSign in accordance with the requirements noted above.

RESOLUTION FOR EXEPMTION FROM AUDIT

(Pursuant to Section 29-1-604. C.R.S.)

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN EXEMPTION FROM AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020 FOR THE LOGHILL VILLAGE PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT, STATE OF COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the Loghill Village Pak and Recreation District wishes to claim exemption from the audit requirements of Section 29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, Section 209-1-604, C.R.S. states that any local government where either revenues nor expenditures exceed seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars may, with approval of the State Auditor, be exempt from the provision of Section 29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, neither revenue nor expenditure for the Loghill Village Park and Recreation District exceeded \$100,000 for Fiscal Year 2020; and

WHEREAS, an application for exemption from audit for the Loghill Village Park and Recreation District has been prepared by Don Moreland & Associates, CPA, a person skilled in governmental accounting; and

WHEREAS, said application for exemption from audit has been completed in accordance with regulations, issued by the State Auditor.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of the Loghill Village Parks and Recreation District that the application for exemption from audit for the Loghill Village Park and Recreation District for the Fiscal Year ended December 31, 2020, has been personally reviewed and is hereby approved by a majority of the Board of the Loghill Village Park and Recreation District: that those members of the Board have signified their approval by singing below; and that this resolution shall be attached to, and shall become a part of, the application for exemption from audit of the Loghill Village Park and Recreation District for the Fiscal Year ended December 31, 2020.
