Policy - Requirements

The Office of the State Auditor Local Government Audit Division may accept an electronic submission of an application for exemption from audit that includes governing board signatures obtained through a program such as DocuSign or EchoSign. Required elements and safeguards are as follows:

- The preparer of the application is responsible for obtaining board signatures that comply with the requirement in Section 29-1-604 (3), C.R.S., that states the application shall be personally reviewed, approved, and signed by a majority of the members of the governing body.
- The application must be accompanied by the signature history document created by the electronic signature software. The signature history document must show when the document was created and when the document was emailed to the various parties, and include the dates the individual board members signed the document. The signature history must also show the individuals' email addresses and IP address.
- Office of the State Auditor staff will not coordinate obtaining signatures.

The application for exemption from audit form created by our office includes a section for governing body approval. Local governing boards note their approval and submit the application through one of the following three methods:

- 1) Submit the application in hard copy via the US Mail including original signatures.
- 2) Submit the application electronically via email and either,
 - a. Include a copy of an adopted resolution that documents formal approval by the Board, or
 - b. Include electronic signatures obtained through a software program such as DocuSign or EchoSign in accordance with the requirements noted above.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR AUDIT EXEMPTION FOR THE GOLD HILL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021.

WHEREAS, the Gold Hill Fire Protection District ("District") is a quasi-municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Colorado, operating and existing pursuant to Title 32 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, and, therefore, is subject to the Colorado Local Government Audit Law § 29-1-601 *et seq.*, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, the District wishes to claim an exemption to the audit requirements of § 29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 29-1-604, C.R.S., any local government with revenues or expenditures in excess of \$100,000, but less than \$750,000, may qualify for an audit exemption, with the approval of the state auditor; and

WHEREAS, neither revenue nor expenditures for the District exceeded \$750,000 in fiscal year 2021; and

WHEREAS, an application for audit exemption has been prepared by Corey Linsenmeyer, an accountant with knowledge in government accounting; and

WHEREAS, the application for audit exemption was prepared in accordance with regulations issued by the state auditor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GOLD HILL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT:

Section 1. The application for audit exemption for the District's 2021 fiscal year has been reviewed and approved by a majority of the Board, as confirmed by the signatures below.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be attached to and incorporated in the application for audit exemption for the District's 2021 fiscal year.






