Policy - Requirements

The Office of the State Auditor Local Government Audit Division may accept an electronic submission of an application for exemption from audit that includes governing board signatures obtained through a program such as DocuSign or Echosign. Required elements and safeguards are as follows:

- The preparer of the application is responsible for obtaining board signatures that comply with the requirement in Section 29-1-604 (3), C.R.S., that states the application shall be personally reviewed, approved, and signed by a majority of the members of the governing body.
- The application must be accompanied by the signature history document created by the electronic signature software. The Galeton Water and Sanitation District, in the County of Weld and State of Colorado, a District duly organized and operating under the constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, for value received, hereby promises to pay solely from the special fund hereafter designated, but not otherwise, to the registered owner named above, or registered assigns, on January 1, in the years and installments set forth below, the principal amount specified above, and in like manner to pay interest on such principal amount (computed on the basis of a 365-day year) from the interest payment date next preceding the date of registration and authentication of this Bond, unless this Bond is registered and authenticated prior to January 1, 1993, in which event this Bond shall bear interest from the dated date hereof, at the interest rate of 5.6250% per annum, payable semiannually on January 1, and July 1, each year, commencing on January 1, 1993, until such principal amount is paid, unless the principal installments of this Bond shall have been previously called for prepayment and payment shall have been duly provided for or made.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN EXEMPTION FROM AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 FOR THE GALETON WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT, STATE OF COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Galeton Water and Sanitation District wishes to claim exemption from the audit requirements of Section 29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, Section 29-1-604, C.R.S., states that any local government where neither revenues nor expenditures exceed seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars may, with the approval of the State Auditor, be exempt from the provision of Section 29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, neither revenues nor expenditures for the GALETON WATER & SANITATION DISTRICT exceeded \$100,000 for Fiscal Year 2021; and

WHEREAS, neither revenues nor expenditures for the GALETON WATER & SANITATION DISTRICT exceeded \$750,000 for Fiscal Year 2021; and

WHEREAS, said application for exemption from audit has been completed in accordance with regulations, issued by the State Auditor.
