### Office of the State Auditor — Local Government Division - Exemption Form Electronic Signatures Policy and Procedure

#### Policy - Requirements

The Office of the State Auditor Local Government Audit Division may accept an electronic submission of an application for exemption from audit that includes governing board signatures obtained through a program such as DocuSign or Echosign. Required elements and safeguards are as follows:

- The preparer of the application is responsible for obtaining board signatures that comply with the requirement in Section 29-1-604 (3), C.R.S., that states the application shall be personally reviewed, approved, and signed by a majority of the members of the governing body.
- The application must be accompanied by the signature history document created by the electronic signature software. The signature history document must show when the document was created and when the document was emailed to the various parties, and include the dates the individual board members signed the document. The signature history must also show the individuals' email addresses and IP address.
- Office of the State Auditor staff will not coordinate obtaining signatures.

**The application for exemption from audit form created by our office includes a section for governing body approval. Local governing boards note their approval and submit the application through one of the following three methods:**

- 1) Submit the application in hard copy via the US Mail including original signatures.
- 2) Submit the application electronically via email and either,

A RESOLUTION/ORDINANCE APPROVING AN EXEMPTION FROM AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020 FOR THE (WALSH METROPOLITAN RECREATION DISTRICT), STATE OF COLORADO.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of the Walsh Metropolitan Recreation District wishes to claim exemption from the audit requirements of Section 29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 29-1-604, C.R.S., states that any local government where neither revenues nor expenditures exceed seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars may, with the approval of the State Auditor be exempt from the provision of Section 29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

(1) **WHEREAS**, neither revenue nor expenditures for the Walsh Metropolitan Recreation District exceeded \$100,000 for Fiscal Year 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, an application for exemption from audit for Walsh Metropolitan Recreation District has been prepared by Larry Harper, a person skilled in governmental accounting; and

**WHEREAS**, an application for exemption from audit has been completed in accordance with regulations, issued by the State Auditor.


