

#### Policy - Requirements

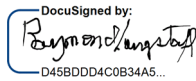

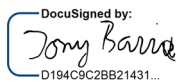
