The District will be required to execute a pledge agreement and levy 10 mills on all taxable property within the District's boundaries. There is no repayment schedule for developer advances. The District's Service Plan addresses total debt in Smith Metropolitan District's Nos 1 through 4, and states that the authorized debt for each district will be reduced by amounts of issued debt in the other districts. No Service Plan restrictions apply to the District at 12/31/24.
