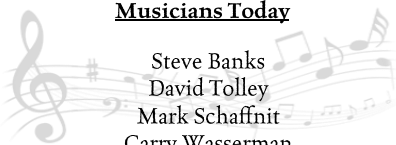
When I feel afraid,

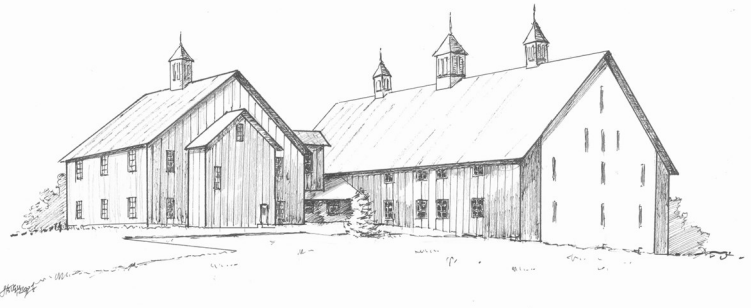
