- What made an impression on you this past Sunday?
- Exodus 3:11-13 Moses and God are having a conversation, and He tells Moses His Name is I AM THAT I AM. What does that mean?
 - I become whoever I become
 - God is everything I need
- How does that relate to Psalms 9:9-10?
 - When you understand that His Name MEANS He is everything we need, it is easy to trust in God!
- What does the name Jehovah mean?
 - To become known as
 - God becomes...
- What are some of the OT names for God and what do they mean?
 - Yahweh (Jehovah)
 - Jireh (Provider) Genesis 22:14
 - Rapha (Healer) Exodus 15:26
 - Nissi (My banner) Exodus 17:15
 - Mekoddishkem (Sanctifies You) Exodus 31:13
 - Shalom (Peace) Judges 6:24
 - Sabaoth (Of Hosts or Armies) 1 Samuel 1:3
 - Raah (Shepherd) Psalms 23
 - Tsidkenu (Our Righteousness) Jeremiah 23:6

- Shammah (Is There) Ezekiel 48:35
- What are Jesus and the Jews talking about in John 8:56-59
 - Abraham saw Jesus
 - The Jews didn't believe that Jesus and Abraham have met
- What did Jesus exclaim in that scripture?
 - Jesus is the I AM
 - It was an echo of Exodus 3:13
- What does the name Jesus mean?
 - Je come from Jehovah
 - Sus means salvation
 - Literally God has become my salvation!
- If Jesus claimed to be the I AM of the OT what is Hebrews 13:8 really saying?
 - God never changes and Jesus Christ is still the I AM of the OT
 - Jesus IS Jehovah Jireh, Nissi, Rapha, etc.
