- o Finally, V. 12
  - Baptism is essential because it symbolizes the death to our flesh, as talked about in V. 11.
  - When we are baptized in Jesus name, we are clean

  - God gives and takes away. We should be thankful when He gives, and be thankful when He takes away.
- Where should we run to when life gets hard according to Psalm 46:1

  - Place of shelter from harm
- Psalms 23:5 says that God prepares a table for us in the midst of our enemies. What does that mean?
