VI. Gospel = Good News!

- A. Rom. 1:16 Gospel is power of God to salvation.
- B. 1Cor. 1:17 Gospel is NOT baptism
- C. 1Cor. 15:1-4 Gospel is defined by God
 - 1. Died for Our Sins- Substitute
 - 2. According to the Scriptures-
Biblical and Prophesied
- D. Gal. 3:8-14 By Faith not Law, as seen in OT.

VII. Death of Christ is Foreshadowed in OT

- Gen. 3:21 Eden-Clothed with skins, shedding of blood.
- Gen. 22:8, 13 Abraham & Isaac foreshadow.
- Ex. 12:21-23 Passover foreshadows.
- Lev. 16:15-16 Day of Atonement foreshadows.

- A. John 1:29, 36 Recognized by John the Baptist.
