HALF DAY • 25–60 PEOPLE • RECOMMENDED: HALF DAY

Support the front lines of your diocesan mission with uplifting formation about how the Holy Spirit empowers them to uniquely build the Church.

Fills: Catechist certification hours, in some dioceses

Catechists & Ministry Leaders

FULL DAY OR HALF DAY • 75–250+ PEOPLE • RECOMMENDED: FULL DAY

What if your regular catechist formation not only helped catechists learn about the faith, but also helped them learn about themselves and why they approach things differently from the person next to them?

Fills: Certification renewal hours

Permanent Deacons

FULL DAY • 40–100 • WIVES WELCOME • RECOMMENDED: FULL DAY

Help your deacons build a Holy Spirit-led vision for their service to the Church.

Fills: Continuing formation hours

Priests

HALF DAY OR CONVOCATION SESSION • 50–150 • RECOMMENDED: HALF DAY

Too many priests are squeezed by the pressure to be all things to all people. Help your priests understand exactly what gifts they've been given so they can experience new clarity in decisions and mission.

Fills: Ongoing formation

School Faculty (one school)

HALF DAY OR FULL DAY • 20–60+ PEOPLE • RECOMMENDED: HALF DAY

Form everyone on your staff to understand how they are uniquely building the Church, whether it's in the classroom, the lunch line, or on the playground.

Fills: Annual faith formation • accreditation evidence

Diocesan School Systems

FULL DAY • 200–1,000 PEOPLE • RECOMMENDED: FULL DAY

Help every educator in your diocese grow in their Catholic identity, understand how they're being uniquely called to build the Church, and articulate their personal path to sainthood.

Fills: Annual faith formation • accreditation evidence • at scale

What every day covers

Four sessions: Identity comes first • What a charism is • The twenty-four charisms • What happens next.

The full day adds: Time to reflect on identity · “Is this you?” for all twenty-four charisms · Charism assessment time built in · Small-group discussion · All three stages of identity · A finished plan.

Format and cost — every day

WHAT	COST
Half day — roughly three hours	\$1,500
Full day	\$1,800
Travel	at cost
Charism assessment, per person	\$6.99

Assessments are billed after the day for the people who actually took one. No estimate of attendance, no block purchased in advance. If your group has already taken the assessment, that line is zero.
