REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)
FOR AXON TASER 10 DEVICES AND RELATED EQUIPMENT

Notice is hereby given that the City of Marion, Indiana, by and through its Board of Public Works and Safety ("Owner"), will receive sealed proposals for the purchase of Axon Taser 10 devices and related equipment, in accordance with Indiana Code § 5-22 and all other applicable laws.

Sealed proposals will be received until 3:00 p.m. (local time) on Friday, October 3, 2025, at the Marion Police Department, 301 S. Branson Street, Marion, IN 46952 (first floor), or by email submission to Deputy Chief Mark Stefanatos at mstefanatos@cityofmarion.in.gov. Proposals received after this time will be returned unopened. All timely submitted proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud at the regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety on Monday, October 6, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. (local time), at City Hall, 301 S. Branson Street, Marion, Indiana.

MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS

Each proposal must provide for the following items and services, with costs allocated over a five (5) year payment plan:

- Sixty-two (62) Axon Taser 10 devices, yellow in color
- Training cartridges
- Live cartridges sufficient for five (5) years
- Cleaning kit
- Safariland holster
- Hook and loop training suit
- Replacement tool
- VR training headset
- Tactical magazine holder
- Dock wall mount
- Taser target
- Instructor course
- Extended warranty for each unit
- Evidence storage license

PROPOSAL CONDITIONS

- Proposals must include a five (5) year payment and equipment plan.
- No proposal may be withdrawn for a period of ten (10) days after the opening date. The City reserves the right to retain all proposals for review during this period.
- The Board of Public Works and Safety reserves the right to waive informalities or irregularities and to reject any or all proposals in the best interest of the City.
- The award will be made to the lowest responsible and responsive proposer, as determined under IC 5-22.
- Conditional or qualified proposals will not be accepted.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- All proposers must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations.

- Each proposer is responsible for reviewing all specifications and conditions. Failure to do so will not relieve any proposer of its obligations.
