0900 Daily Briefing;

The Grant County Health Department has reported **39, confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 2 deaths** in Grant County.

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) has identified 8,236 total presumptive positive cases of COVID-19 and 350 deaths and 44,539 tests in the state since Friday, March 6.

Marion Community Schools will conduct a food distribution on Wednesday April 10¹⁵, 2020 from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM same place as it has been.

Also, 2nd Harvest food bank will be having a food distribution April 25th 2020 in the old Sears parking lot at five point's mall from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM.

As we look to begin the recovery process in Grant County it is vital that our local businesses and manufacturing facilities start coming back online in the safest possible manner. With the proper PPE and cleaning activities along with physical distancing any business should be able to operate safely.
