Do You Have Home Repair Needs? The City of Marion Wants to Hear From You.

MARION, INDIANA, Thursday, July 9th, 2026 - The City of Marion is seeking input from local homeowners about home repair needs throughout Marion neighborhoods. If you or someone you know owns a home in Marion that needs home repairs—roof, HVAC, accessibility updates, or electrical work—we want to hear from you. This survey is part of the City of Marion's effort to secure \$350,000 in state funding for home repairs through the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA)'s [Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation \(OOR\)](#) program. The application will be submitted as part of Cycle 3, ahead of the November 1, 2026 deadline. If awarded, the funds will support critical home repairs of up to \$25,000 per household for low- and moderate-income homeowners in Marion.
