# **REVIEW OF MINUTES:**

January 7, 2020, minutes were read for approval. (Motion by Mr. Ott, Seconded by Mr. Carmin) Motion Approved RECURRING ITEMS:

# 1. AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

- a. AIP-28...T-Hangar Taxiway Construction
  - Awaiting grant close-out letter
- b. AIP-29...SRE Building Reimbursement
  - i. Awaiting grant close-out letter
- c. Future AIP-31: Construct T-Hangar Taxiway (Phase 3)
  - i. AIP Pre-application was submitted on 11/27/2020. Total project cost estimated at: \$512,495. Expected contributions for the project are: FAA: \$461.245, INDOT: \$25,625, Local: \$25,625
  - ii. Woolpert requests BOAC approval for Design/Engineering Services in the amount of \$25,000 (FAA: \$22,500, INDOT: \$1,250, Local: \$1,250) (Motion by Mr. Johnson, Seconded by Mr. Carmin) Motion Approved

# 2. AIRPORT MANAGEMENT ITEMS

- a. Airport Management Report
  - i. Snow removal equipment is all functioning as expected.
  - ii. MZZ has a new aircraft on the field. Two additional aircraft are expected to be on the field within the next few months.
  - iii. Air Marion will host Indiana Wesleyan University ROTC Aviation Cadets June 12 August 7.
  - iv. The Roll Race Event has requested August 14th for the event date and paperwork for the event has begun.
  - v. The High School Aviation Program is operating at a reduced level due to COVID and the school's modified schedule.

### b. Primary Runway/Taxiway Surface Monitoring

a. The pavement is in overall good condition with recent snowfall. All surfaces are currently clear.

# c. Routine Management/Maintenance Items

- a. <u>Building of new hangars at the airport:</u> Construction operations have begun on the T-Hangar. Construction is expected to be completed within four weeks as long as winter weather is conducive to construction.
- b. <u>PHI Hangar Inquiry:</u> Operations are expected to begin on March 15. Awaiting security deposit from PHI prior to beginning operations.
- c. <u>Clearing of the north end of Runway 22:</u> BOAC is awaiting contact from Glendale Lake Association to clarify clearing of this area.
- d. MZZ Solar Project: Awaiting contact from JMS to schedule the next meeting to discuss the project further.
- e. <u>CIP for 2022-2026</u>: CIP was submitted to INDOT on 2/1/21. CIP was also sent to City Council Members in January.
- f. <u>Terminal/Airport Signage</u>: Letters are in and waiting on Install. Electric sign is supposed to arrive on February 22nd.

### **NEW ITEMS**

- a. Insurance Coverage: Mr. Ashley reported to the BOAC on our current insurance coverage. As a part of this Mr. McKinney asked Mr. Ott and Mr. Johnson to conduct a review of all airport property and equipment.
- b. Hangar B North Field: BOAC discussed the continued use of the existing farm ground north of Hangar B and the new hangars under construction. BOAC elected to remove the field from crop service and convert it into a grass field.
- c. Grant Oversight Risk Assessment: Mr. McCroskey presented the Grant Oversight Risk Assessment to the BOAC. BOAC approved the assessment as presented.

### **BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS**

- a. Status of EMS Tower: Mr. Ott expressed concern about the EMS tower South East of the airport as it appears to be in or near the approach corridor to Runway 4. This will be investigated.
- b. Portable Jet Fuel Tank: BOAC discussed AMI purchasing a portable fuel tank for PHI helicopter to use as opposed to moving a static tank to another location. BOAC supports AMI in this purchase.
