

**BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY  
DECEMBER 15, 2025  
MEETING MINUTES**

The Board of Public Works and Safety met on Monday, December 15, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers on the first floor of City Hall, located at 301 S. Branson St., Marion, IN 46952.

**1. ROLL CALL**

President Alex Huskey called the meeting to order and noted that a quorum was present.

**2. APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES**

**3. CITY OF MARION – PROCUREMENT POLICY FOR EXPENDITURES USING FEDERAL FUNDS**

Attorney Hotz presented the proposed procurement policy for expenditures using federal funds, explaining its importance for audit compliance and the need to align federal, state, and grant-specific requirements. Discussion included clarification that applicable local approval thresholds would still apply and that expenditures would be evaluated on a case-by-case basis to ensure compliance with all governing regulations. President Huskey emphasized preserving the intent of the policy on record for future administrations.

Alex Huskey entertained a motion to approve Resolution 9-2025 approving the procurement policy.

**4. STREET DEPARTMENT – EQUIPMENT PURCHASE**

Mr. Hiatt presented a request to purchase two vehicles for the Street Department:

- One 2025 Ford F-150 Crew Cab 4x4 (\$51,664.95)
- One 2025 Ford F-250 Crew Cab 4x4 (\$61,283.63)

He explained the decision to move away from Dodge trucks due to significant maintenance issues and to purchase Ford vehicles from a local dealer for reliability, service availability, and improved performance for plowing, towing, and alley work. Board discussion included bid comparisons, maintenance costs of older fleet vehicles, and the need to obtain three competitive bids for future purchases.

Alex Huskey entertained a motion to approve the purchase of both vehicles, using the Street Maintenance account.
