BOARD MEETING
November 3, 2025

Meeting called to order at 12:00 pm by Kellie Street.

Motion to approve minutes from October 6, 2025 meeting was made by Jim Gartland; second by Bria Coil. Motion carried.

New Business:

Resolution 3

Joe Murphy presented Resolution 3, explaining that it serves as the confirmatory resolution in the two-step bond process, following the declaratory resolution that was passed in the previous meeting. He stated that the purpose of this resolution is to officially identify the projects included in the bond, confirm their public benefit, and establish the need for each project. **As required, the meeting was opened for a public hearing; however, no members of the public were present. The public hearing was then closed.**

Motion made to approve moving forward with Resolution 3 was made by Jim Gartland; second by Bria Coil. Motion carried.

Resolution 4

Joe Murphy presented Resolution 4, explaining that it serves as the authorization to issue the bond. He noted that this resolution outlines the financial terms of the bond—up to \$2 million, with a maximum interest rate of 6% and a 10-year term—and details how the bonds are to be structured, priced, and sold. He also stated that no public hearing is required for Resolution 4.

Motion made to approve moving forward with Resolution 4 was made by Jim Gartland; second by Bria Coil. Motion carried.

Resolution 5

Joe Murphy presented Resolution 5, explaining that it serves as the appropriation needed to add the bond funds into the 2025 budget, since these funds were not included in the original budget. He noted that this appropriation is necessary for the board to access and utilize the bond money for the approved projects. **As required, the meeting was opened for a public hearing; however, no members of the public were present. The public hearing was then closed.**

Motion made to approve moving forwards with Resolution 5 was made by Jim Brunner; second by Bria Coil. Motion carried.
