



## Cookies Policies

User cookies allow us to enhance your user experience and give you access to the website's certain features.

Our ICO website automatically accesses cookies of all users that visit it, unless they disabled them in the browser settings beforehand. In such case, some features could be unavailable for users who don't allow the website to access cookies.

We guarantee that we don't use the data collected using cookies for any personal gain and we don't share it with third parties unless we are legally obligated to or we need to do so for security purposes. In turn, in case we detect fraudulent activity, cookies can be used by us or law enforcement representatives as the source of proofs such activities took place.

In this document, we will disclose what cookies types we use, for what purposes, and explain how to disable them if needed.

### What Are Cookies?

Cookies are files with information stored on the hard drive of the device you use to visit our website. Their main purpose is to collect data on user activity on the website.

Almost all today's mass-market browsers generate cookies automatically. If you want to prevent data collection and analyzing your activity on our website, you will have to disable them in your browser settings.

However, in case you prohibit generating cookies, certain features of our website will become unavailable to you.

Every cookie is unique for a particular server, so other servers can't access it. This is why cookies can't be used to identify a certain user.

### What Types of Cookies Do We Use?

We use the following types of cookies:

- **strictly necessary type.** This type of cookies gives our users access to our website's functionality (for instance, to your user account and its settings, making transactions, etc.);

- **performance type.** These files provide our website administrators with statistical data on its performance;
- **functionality type.** This cookie type's purpose is to identify users in case they return to our website. Consequently, you can personalize the access to our services (for instance, save the language settings and stay logged in without having to authorize again);
- **targeting type.** These cookies store the data on user activities on our platform. This allows us to optimize the user experience and get information on the traffic and the target audience.

## How Long Do We Store Cookies?

Cookies are files with an expiration date. In particular, our servers store them for two years since the moment of their generation.

## Can I Disable Cookies?

Depending on the type of cookies you've decided to disable, you risk making the certain functionality of our website inaccessible to yourself.
