Bondage

Slavery or involuntary servitude;

The state of being bound by or subjected to some external power or control.

The state or practice of being physically restrained, as by being tied up, chained, or put in handcuffs, The word bondage come from the Greek word “douleuo” doolyoo’-o which means to be a slave to (literal or figurative, involuntary or voluntary):

What is the Spirit of Bondage?

Breaking Free From The Spirit Of Bondage

The spirit of bondage, is basically anything and everything that keeps you from being all that God created you to be. The spirit of bondage is anything and everything that limits your potential. It is manifested in and through any person who holds you back and keeps you from being all that God created you to be. The spirit of bondage is any attitude, person, thing, addiction, sin that keeps you from being all that God intends for you to be. **ANYTHING that BINDS YOU, HOLDS YOU, and KEEPS YOU FROM KNOWING AND DOING GOD'S WILL is the result of THE SPIRIT OF BONDAGE.**

Any form of ADDICTION is the result of the spirit of BONDAGE. Addiction to alcohol, drugs, gambling, lying, cigarettes, excessive eating (gluttony), satanic music (any music that has negative, destructive, vulgar, abusive, demeaning, sexually explicit, unholy, unwholesome, ungodly lyrics) is the result of the spirit of bondage.

Breaking Free From The Spirit Of Bondage

We attempt to alleviate ourselves from bondage thru sex, drugs, alcohol, gambling, making money, exotic travel, obtaining power and position or any other means by which the world measures success or freedom! We try what the world has to offer, and it will bring to us a measure of pleasure a pittance of satisfaction, but we are still in bondage.

Paul still makes it clear that THE VICTORY is in and through JESUS CHRIST. For he says in Philippians 4:13, “I can do EVERYTHING through Him (Christ) who gives me strength”, NIV. Therefore, in spite of the spiritual battle with the spirit of bondage and all other satanic spirits, the VICTORY can be OUR’S in and through Jesus Christ!

How Do You BREAK the
Spirit of Bondage?

Breaking Free From The Spirit Of Bondage

**FIRST: We need to identify
our spirit of bondage.**

**Before we can break a spirit of
bondage, we have to know what
it is. If we want to break the spirit
of bondage, we must first identify
that spirit.**

SECONDLY: We need to bind our spirit of bondage.

After we identify it, after we know what it is, we have to bind it.

HOW? How can we bind the spirit of bondage? CALL IT by name! TELL IT, “In the Name of Jesus, I bind you!”

THIRDLY: We need to loose the spirit of freedom

We need to loose the spirit of freedom from your identified spirit (or spirits) of bondage. AFTER we bind our spirit of bondage, we need to loose the spirit of freedom. WHY? *Because Jesus said, “WHATEVER you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven” (Matthew 18:18b). Therefore, AFTER we bind that spirit (by name), loose the spirit of freedom. LOOSE the spirit of freedom from that satanic spirit. LOOSE IT, “In the Name of Jesus!”

Breaking Free From The Spirit Of Bondage

FOURTHLY: After we loose the spirit of freedom, then accept our freedom in Christ!

That means believe that Christ has set you free! THAT MEANS: Claim your freedom!

Claim your freedom in Christ! WHY?

Because the Word says, “It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery” (Galatians 5:1)

Breaking Free From The Spirit Of Bondage

FINALLY: After we accept our freedom in Christ, then start living as God's child!

WHY? Because Romans 8:15-17 tells us, "For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship. And by him we cry, 'Abba, Father.' The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. Now if we are children, then we are heirs --- heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory."

WHY? Because Jesus said, “I have come that they may have LIFE, and have it to the full” (John 10:10, NIV; emphasis mine)

Gal 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage. KJV

Tell somebody I'm Free....

Once you become a child of God you can have freedom from bondage

John 8:32 and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free."

John 8:36 "So if the Son makes you free, you will be free indeed.

HOLY FATHER, I acknowledge You as my God and Father and thank you for the privilege and power of prayer. I thank you for the blood of Jesus that cleanses me from all sin and unrighteousness. FATHER GOD, In the Name of Jesus, I ask now that You forgive me of all known and unknown sins, of all sins of omission and commission, of all sins committed intentionally and unintentionally, of all sins of thought, word, and deed.

ESPECIALLY, HOLY FATHER, I ask now, In the Name of Jesus, that you forgive me for allowing the spirit of bondage to enter me and influence me against Your will. FATHER GOD, In the Name of Jesus, I bind the spirit of bondage and cast it out of my life now and forever.

Breaking Free From The Spirit Of Bondage

HOLY FATHER, REPLACE the spirit of bondage with the spirit of freedom.

REPLACE each satanic spirit with Your HOLY SPIRIT in order that, from this day forward, I will glorify YOU in ALL that I THINK, in ALL that I SAY, and in ALL that I DO. FATHER GOD, these things I ASK, these things I CLAIM by faith, IN the Name of Jesus, ON the strength of His shed blood, and THROUGH Your DIVINE HOLY SPIRIT. Amen!
