As Birmingham's main economic engine, UAB has over 21,000 employees and 21,000 students. With a \$7.15 billion annual economic impact, the collegeand hospital prove to be much of the reason behind Birmingham's recent momentum. UAB is showing solid overall growth in both the medical and educational branches of the campus. Salaries at UAB Hospital alone have increased dramatically over the lastyear (7.8%), as patient visits and hospital traffic continue to grow. UAB Hospital is a major center for clinical research and the home of some of the top medical programs in America. The faculty physicians, nursing staff, and support personnel are committed to providing world-class care to every patient.

The centerpiece of UAB's clinical enterprise, UAB Hospital is located in Birmingham's Medical District. In the midst of UAB's major research centers and clinics, the 1,157-licensed-bed hospital is among the 20 largest and best equipped in the nation.

Ten medical specialties at UAB Hospital are ranked in the top 50 in the nation, according to the 2017-2018 Best Hospitals ranking from U.S. News & World Report. Four other specialties are listed as 'high-performing,' and UAB Hospital is again ranked as No. 1 in the state of Alabama. With ten specialties ranked in the nation's top 50, UAB topped several peer institutions, including Vanderbilt University, University of North Carolina and Emory University, which had seven, six and five ranked specialties respectively.
