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



In the identified market area, the current year population is 63,363. In 2000, the Census count in the market area was 58,285. The rate of change since 2000 was 0.82 percent annually. The household count in this market area has changed from 17,767 in 2000 to 19,362 in the current year, a change of 0.84 percent annually. The five-year projection of households is 20,528, a change of 1.18 percent annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 3.20, compared to 3.20 in the year 2000. The number of families in the current year is 14,936 in the market area.

Housing

Currently, 59.3 percent of the 21,189 housing units in the market area are owner occupied; 32.1 percent, renter occupied; and 8.6 percent are vacant. In 2000, there were 18,954 housing units - 63.4 percent owner occupied, 30.3 percent renter occupied and 6.2 percent vacant. The rate of change in housing units since 2000 is 1.09 percent. Median home value in the market area is \$61,939, compared to a median home value of \$157,913 for the U.S. In five years, median home value is projected to change by 3.78 percent annually to \$74,581. From 2000 to the current year, median home value changed by 3.1 percent annually.

Households by Income

Current median household income is \$36,904 in the market area, compared to \$54,442 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$44,381 in five years. In 2000, median household income was \$29,868, compared to \$21,158 in 1990.

Current average household income is \$43,279 in this market area, compared to \$70,173 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$48,095 in five years. In 2000, average household income was \$36,893, compared to \$24,400 in 1990.

Currently, 88.1 percent of the civilian labor force in the identified market area is employed and 11.9 percent are unemployed. In comparison, 89.2 percent of the U.S. civilian labor force is employed, and 10.8 percent are unemployed. In five years the rate of employment in the market area will be 90.1 percent of the civilian labor force, and unemployment will be 9.9 percent. The percentage of the U.S. civilian labor force that will be employed in five years is 91.2 percent, and 8.8 percent will be unemployed. In 2000, 56.4 percent of the population aged 16 years or older in the market area participated in the labor force, and 0.7 percent were in the Armed Forces.

In the current year, the occupational distribution of the employed population is:

- 44.4 percent in white collar jobs (compared to 61.6 percent of U.S. employment)

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




Trends 2011-2016




Population by Age

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




Trends 2011-2016




Population by Age







Population by Age
