



West Washington is one block north (1/8th mile) of Main Street and goes west approximately 12 miles to the Kinzua Dam and New York State. Bradford City serves as the regional hub for services and is home to the Regional Hospital, the University of Pittsburgh at Bradford, State Career Link Center, and Beacon Light Behavioral Health Systems. Home to 3 intermediate/extended care facilities and assisted living facility. The area has a strong manufacturing base with Zippo, Case Cutlery, Bradford Forest Products, Werzalit Inc, ARG Petroleum Products, Dresser Manufacturing, Top LinePepperill Braiding, and many others, providing stable jobs. 







