





#### Las Vegas Convention Center

The Las Vegas Convention Center (LVCC), located adjacent to the Las Vegas Strip, encompasses approximately 3.2 million square feet with exhibit space of 2 million square feet and meeting space of nearly 250,000 square feet. This is one of the largest convention centers in the world. The facility is also billed as one of the busiest centers in the world – with shows in excess of 200,000 attendees – it enjoys a location with immediate access to more than 100,000 hotel rooms thanks to the Las Vegas Monorail.

The LVCC is undergoing a long-term expansion project, phase one of which ended in January 2017 with the purchase and demolition of the Riviera Hotel property. Phase two will further explain the space, which will mean the building of a new exhibit hall. This addition will add more than 86,000 square feet of meeting spaces and improved monorail access.
