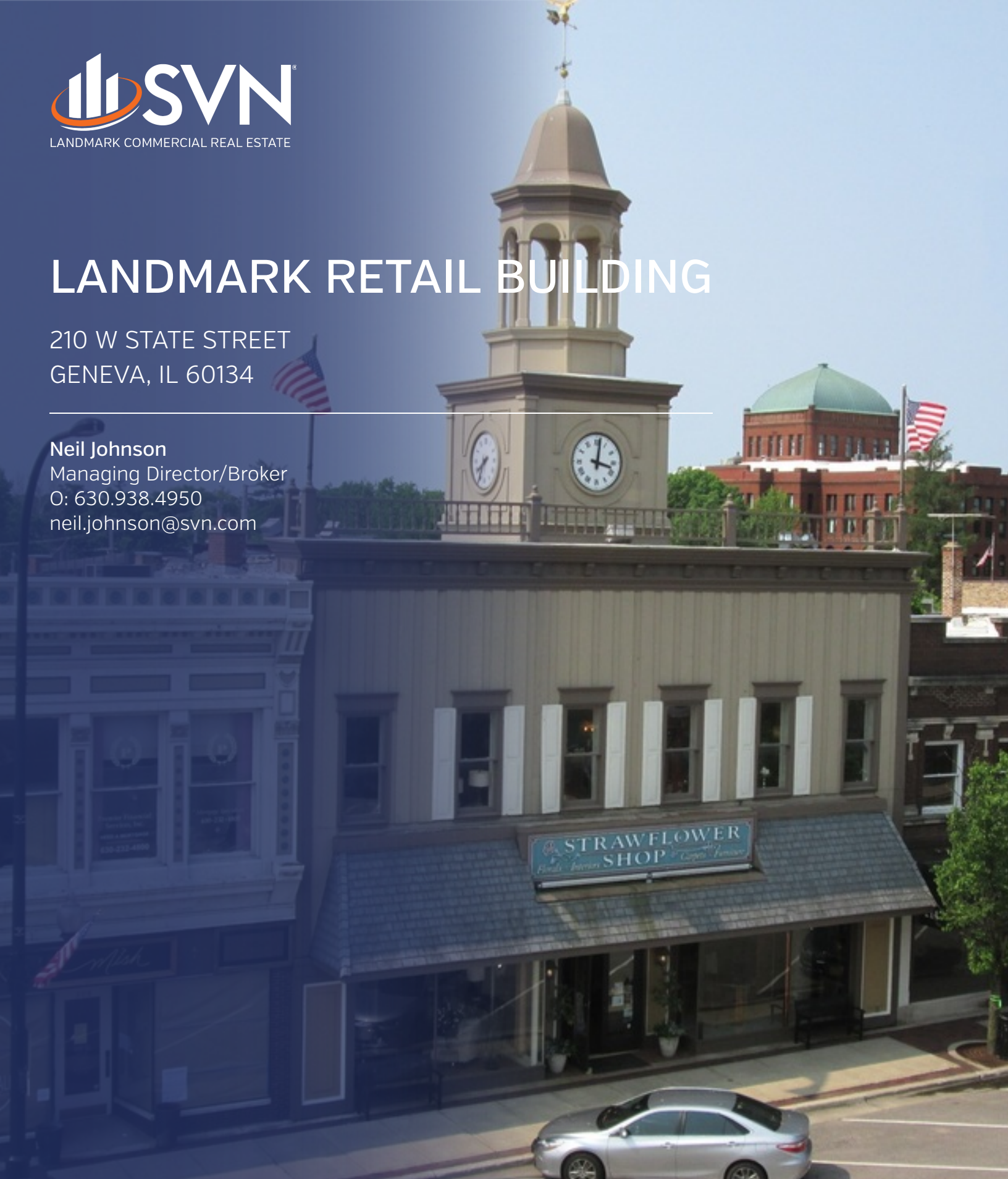

PROPERTY OVERVIEW

210 W State is a large, landmark anchor retail building in downtown Geneva IL, currently occupied by the Strawflower Shop, a long-standing anchor business. [The owners plan to downsize after the sale]. The entire property (original plus addition) consists of two full storefronts with two stories, plus a partial mezzanine (838 sf) and full basement, totaling 17,193 sf. The original 1910 building is 9,267 sf above grade, plus 4,105 sf basement. The 2001 addition consists of 2,592 sf on two stories, plus 1,229 sf basement area for a total of 3,821 sf.

The main building features prominent storefront display windows, distinctive historic interior finishes, including narrow-board hardwood floors and original tin ceilings and crown moulding. The showrooms feature extensive display lighting. The second floor features additional showrooms, offices and kitchen facilities for employees. A newer elevator provides access to all three levels. All mechanical and electrical systems have been updated. The basement areas are clean & dry and have long been used for showroom display, production and storage. The building is fully sprinklered. 2019 Taxes: \$32,285

In addition, there is an optional detached 2,760 sf 1-story 1940 warehouse (18 S 2nd St) behind the main building. The warehouse building is accessed by alleys from both 2nd Street and James Street. The price of the warehouse building is \$234,600 [\$85/sf]. 2019 Taxes: \$4,193

LOCATION OVERVIEW

Downtown Geneva IL is one of the principal boutique retail destinations in suburban Chicago. State St [IL Rt 38] is a primary east-west corridor and the main street through town. The property is located just 2 blocks west of the Fox River bridge and 1/2 block east of Third Street, a major element of the downtown retail area. Traffic Counts [IDOT]: 23,800 VPD.

Geneva IL is an upscale suburb about an hour west of Chicago. Downtown Geneva is teeming with unique shops and restaurants, and benefits by being a stop on the Metra commuter train line. Geneva is the county seat of Kane County, which is recognized for the scenic Fox River, beautiful open spaces, a diverse economy, and comparatively low real estate taxes.

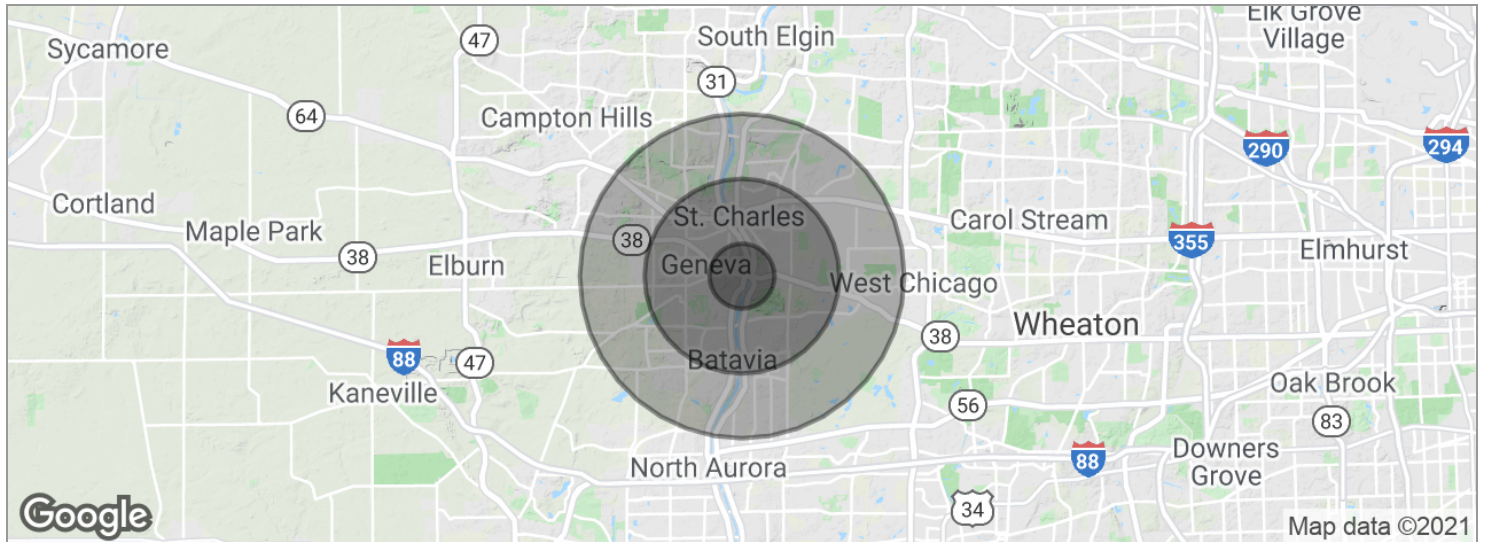
