19 N. California Street was home to the Pioneer Tamale Factory in the 1920's.

Bing Crosby discovered their tamales while filming "High Time" in Stockton in 1960 and often ate at The Pioneer. After the movie wrapped, Crosby would often send for shipments of their famous tamales.

The property was known for its paintings of early California done by Italian artist Angelo Lanzini.

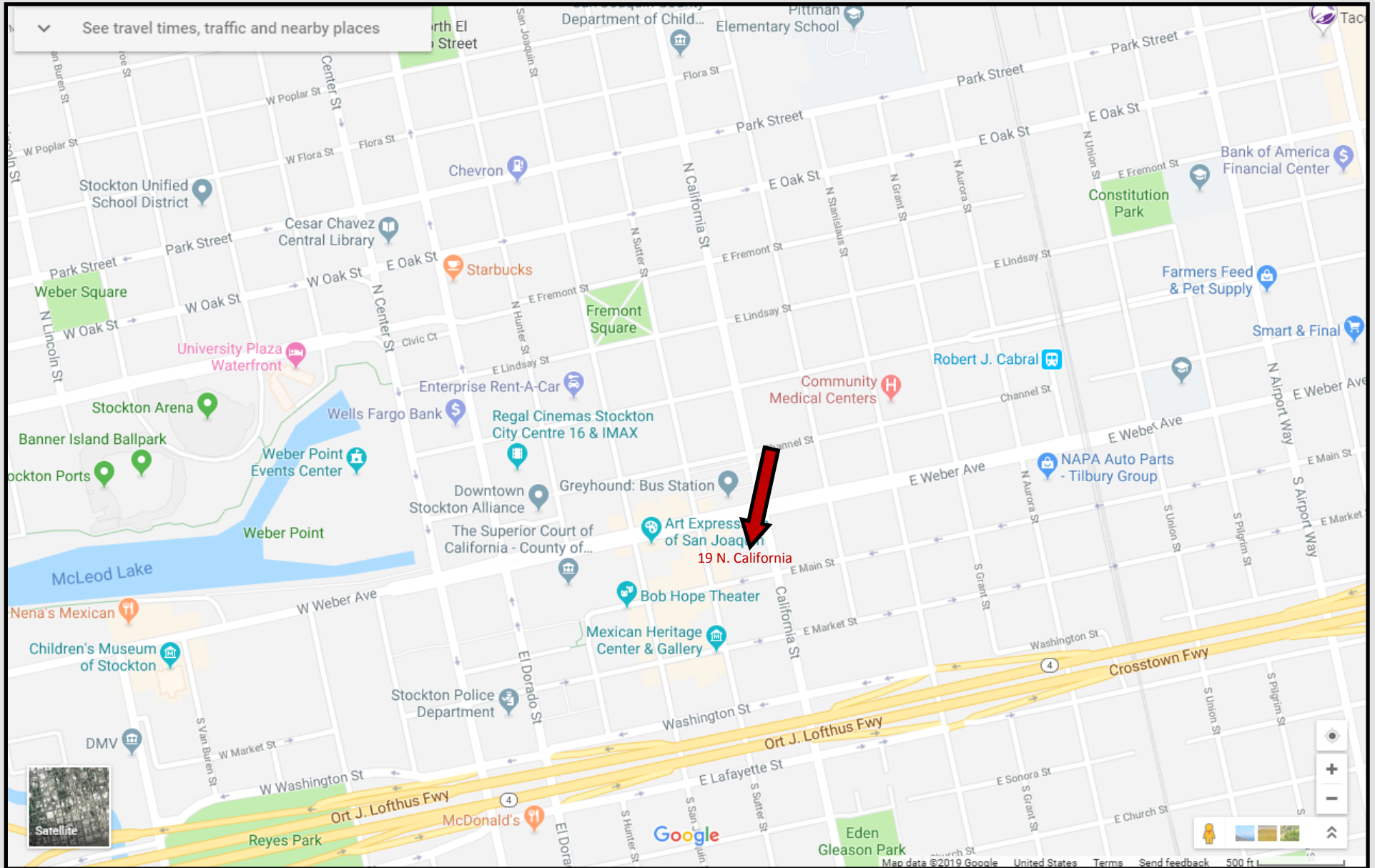
