

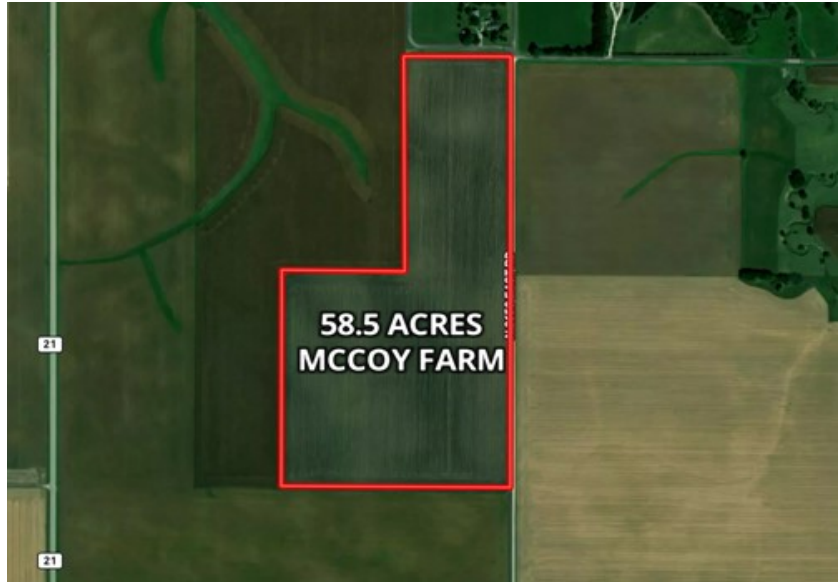

This parcel is located between Chicago and St. Louis along I-55 and historic US Route 66.

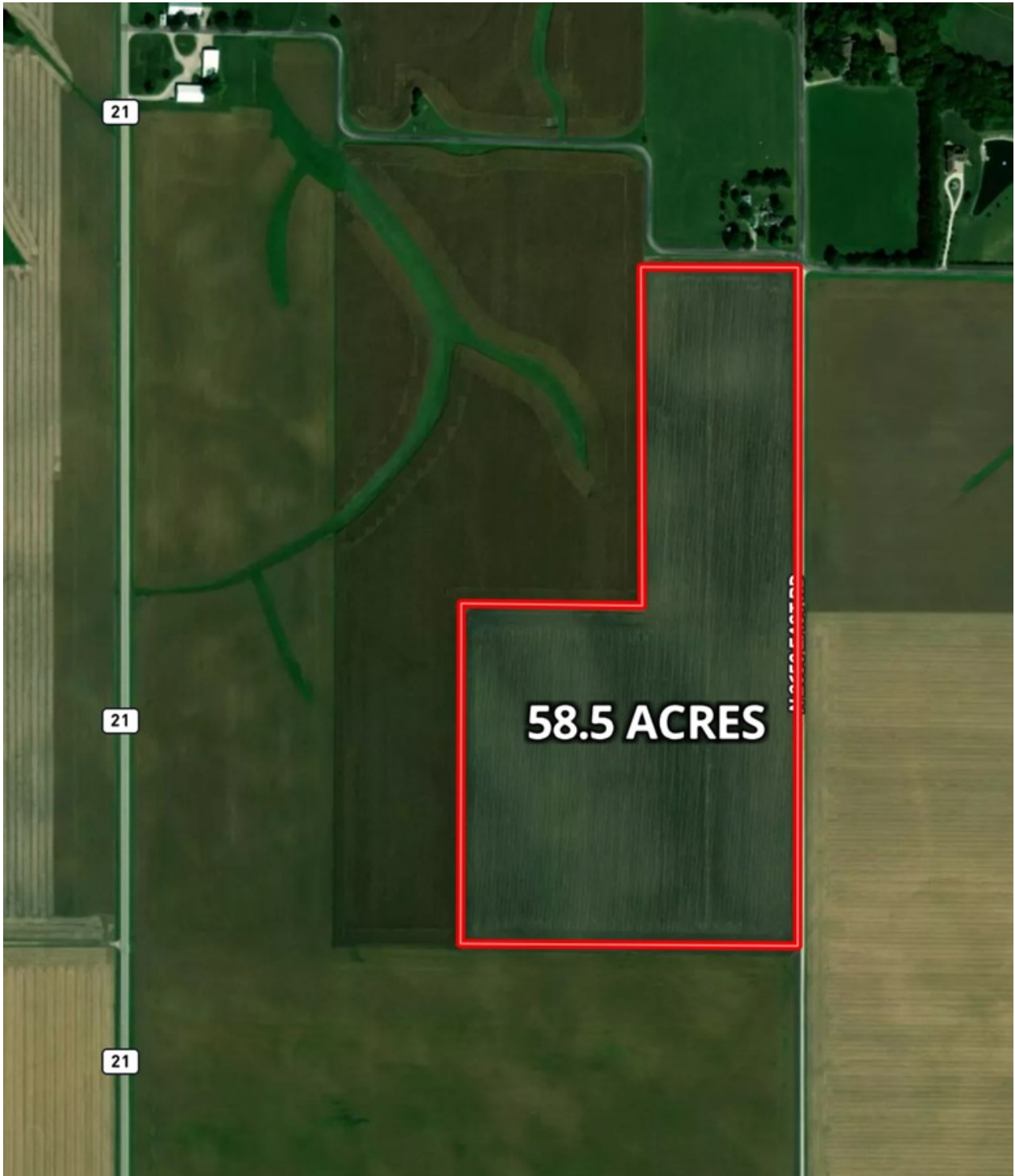


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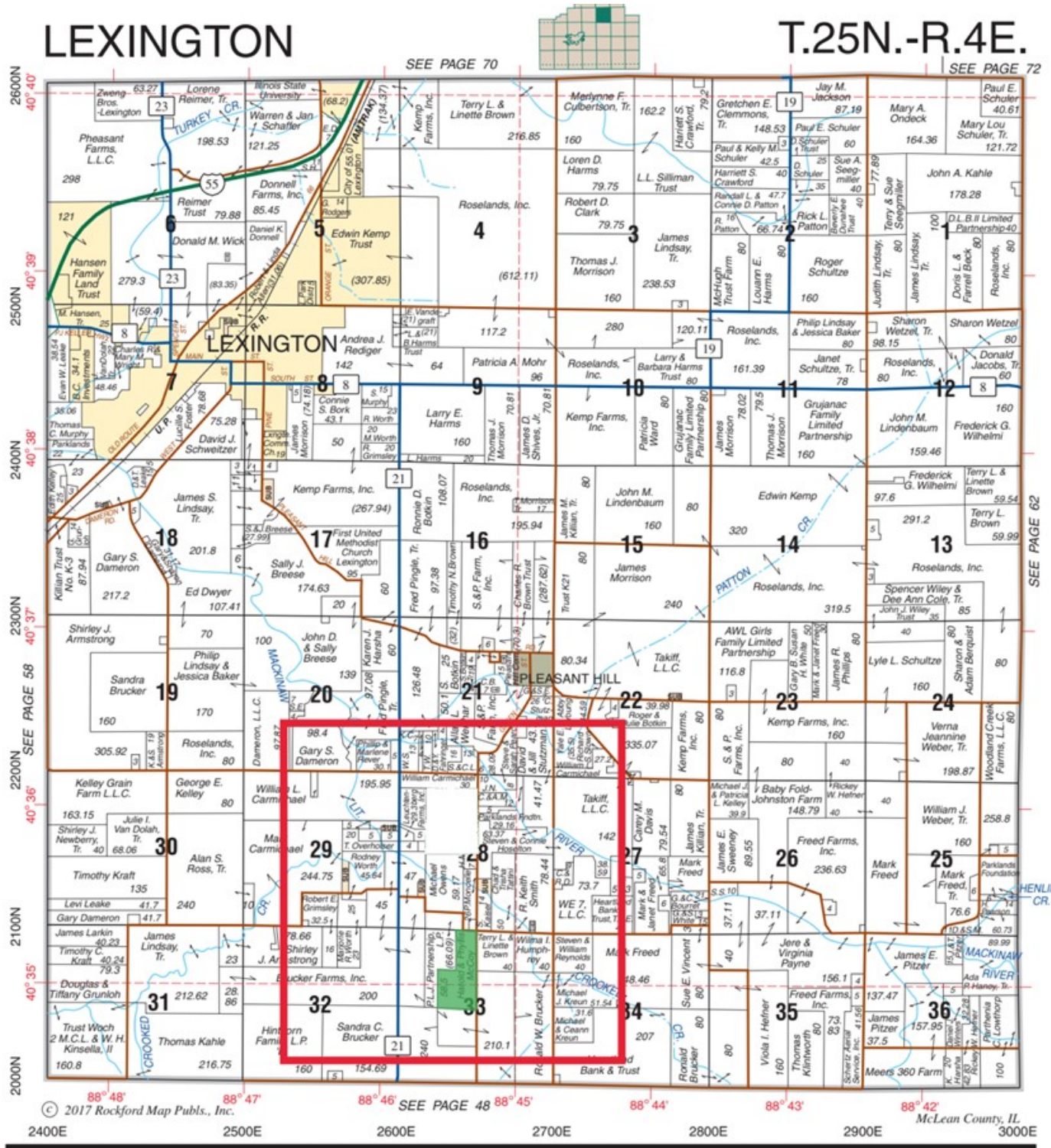
AREA MAP 58 ACRE MCCOY FARM, LEXINGTON TOWNSHIP, MCLEAN COUNTY

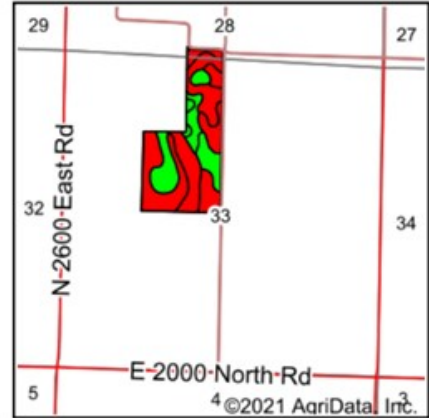
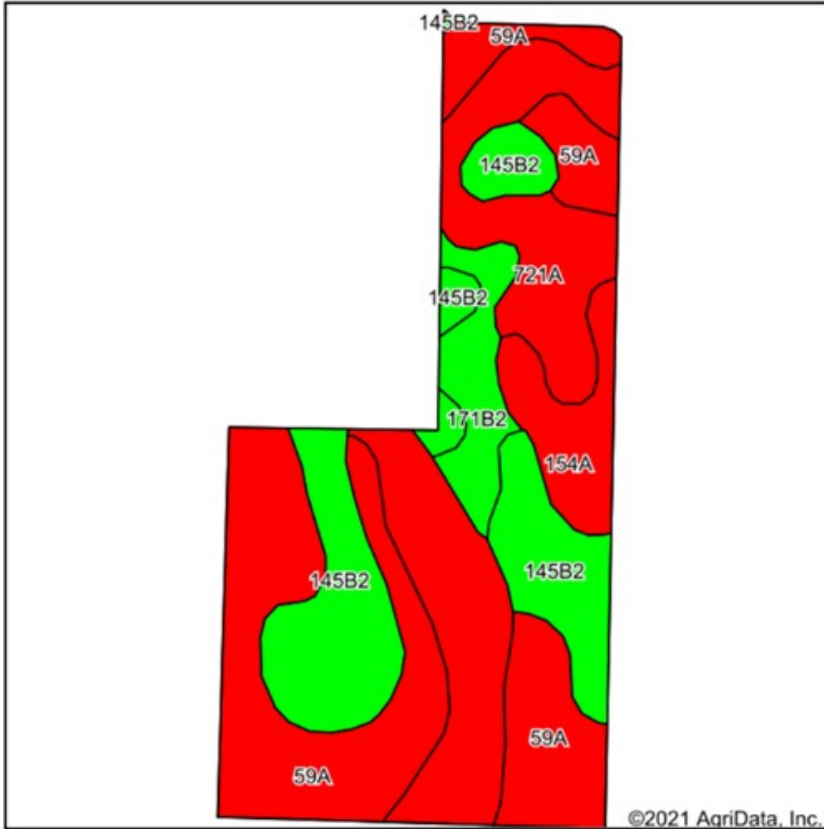
FSA MAP 58 ACRE MCCOY FARM, LEXINGTON TOWNSHIP, MCLEAN COUNTY

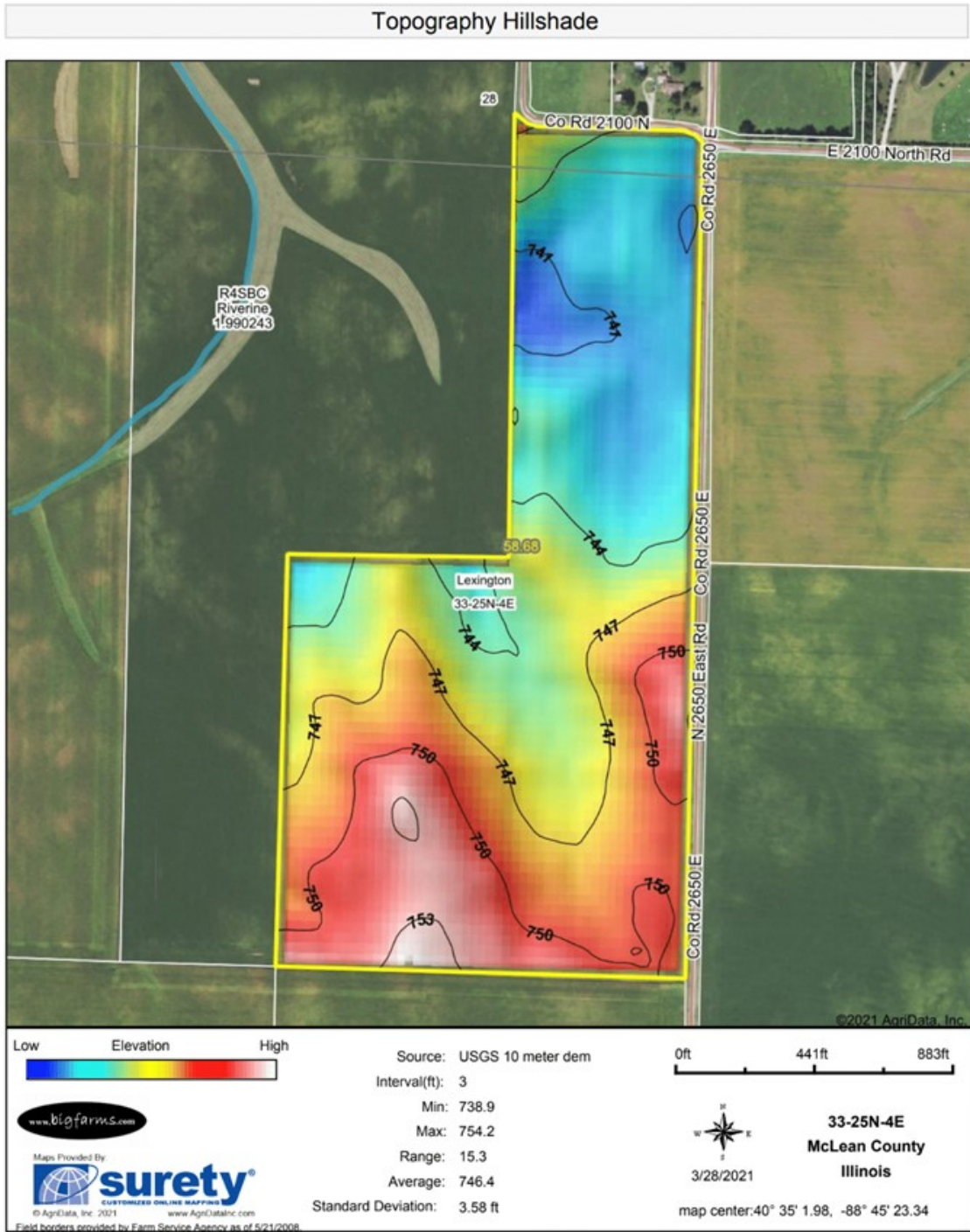

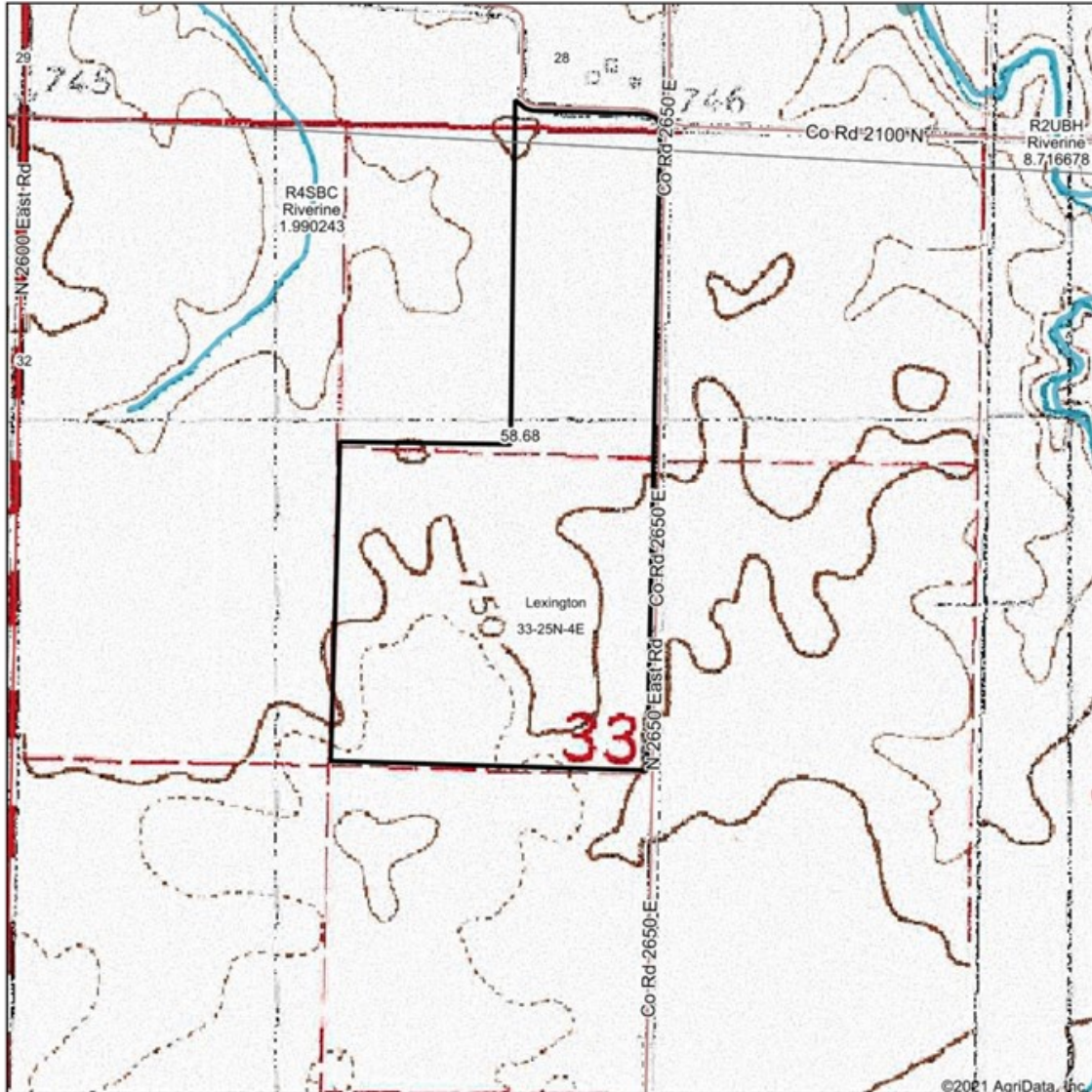

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
