

Currently, 79.5% of the 20,771 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 14.0%, renter occupied; and 6.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 18,785 housing units in the area - 80.9% owner occupied, 13.3% renter occupied, and 5.9% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.57%. Median home value in the area is \$175,495, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.82% annually to \$182,778.
