## DISCUSS

Use the prompts below to inspire and encourage discussion with one another.

- Sunday was the end of the "Doxa" sermon series. What have you learned about God's glory during the past few weeks?
- Read John 15:1-8. What is the main thought that Jesus conveys? What especially stood out to you from BJ's message?
- Jesus claimed to be the true vine, said His Father is the gardener (or vine dresser), and indicated that we are the branches. In this metaphor (word picture), what is expected of the vine...the gardener...the branches?
- Read the following (divide between group members) and notice what each passage teaches us about bearing fruit: Matthew 3:8; Romans 6:22; Romans 7:4; Ephesians 5:8-9; Philippians 1:21-24; Colossians 1:3-6. When we combine those passages with John 15, what level of importance do you think God is assigning to the bearing of fruit.
- How can you bear fruit in the church? How can you bear fruit in the community? How can you bear fruit to those closest to you?

- Pray for your group, that its members would bear fruit that brings glory to God.
