Mr. Concoff co-founds the Entertainment Symposium at the University of California, Los Angeles, where he serves as co-chair.

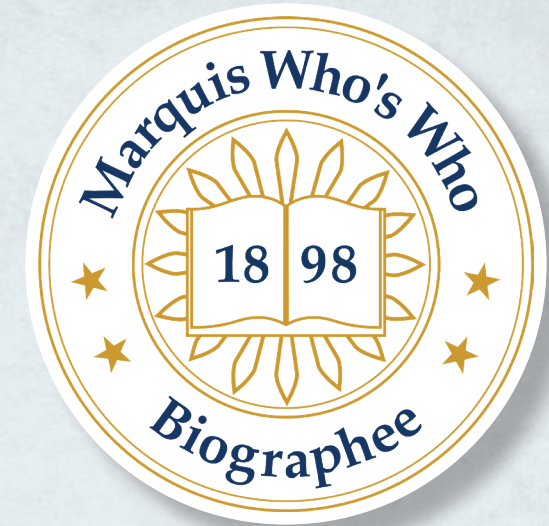
1976
