INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

RhinoRoof® SL is an air, water and vapor barrier and therefore must be installed above a properly ventilated space(s). Follow ALL building codes applicable to your geographical region and structure type as it is considered a vapor barrier.

DECK PREP: All protrusions from the deck area must be removed and ensure the deck has no voids, damaged or unsupported areas. Deck surface should be free of debris, dry and moisture free.

USE: RhinoRoof SL must be covered by primary roofing within 60 days of application. SL is designed for use under asphalt shingles, synthetic shingles, residential metal roofing and cedar shakes.

APPLICATION: For slopes from 4:12 and higher RhinoRoof SL is to be laid out horizontally (parallel) to the eave with the printed side up. Horizontal laps should be 4" and Vertical laps should be 6" and anchored approximately 1" in from the edge. For low slope (less than 4:12) applications it is recommended to overlap 50% plus 1", for complete definition of low slope and guidelines consult authorities having jurisdiction. SL product is not recommended for slopes less than 2:12. The use of roofing hammer, pneumatic air or gas driven fastener tools is acceptable. The use of straight edge cutting knives is recommended.

FASTENERS: For **same day** coverage with primary roofing RhinoRoof SL can be anchored with corrosive resistant 3/8" head x 1" leg roofing nails (ring shank preferred, smooth leg acceptable). The use of every other anchoring location printed on the product is also acceptable. **DO NOT USE STAPLES:** the use of staples to penetrate RhinoRoof SL will void warranty.

ANCHORING: All anchoring nails must be flush, 90 degrees to the roof deck, and tight with the underlayment surface and the structural roof deck. Where seams and joints require sealant or adhesive use a low solvent plastic roofing cement meeting ASTM D-4586 Type 1, or Federal Spec SS-153 Type 1 such as Karnak, Henry, DAP, MB, Geocel or equivalent. Acceptable alternatives are butyl rubber, urethane, and EDPM based caulk or tape sealant.

EXTENDED EXPOSURE: If RhinoRoof SL product will be exposed longer than 24 hours and up to 60 days then product must be attached to the structural roof deck using a minimum 1" diameter plastic or metal cap roofing nails (ring shank preferred but smooth leg acceptable). Miami-Dade approved tin tags or metal caps are also acceptable, and it is recommended for best performance to use with the rough edge facing up. For extended exposure it is always recommended to anchor on every printed position on the facer. RhinoRoof SL is not designed for indefinite outdoor exposure. For extended exposure conditions where driving rain or strong winds are expected it is recommended to take additional precautions such as doubling the lap widths. Alternately or in addition to a compatible sealant could be used between the laps or a peel and stick tape could be applied to the overlaps.

CAUTION - READ GOOD SAFETY PRACTICES BELOW

Good safety practices should be followed on steep slope roofs, such as use of tie-offs, toe boards, ladders and/or safety ropes and personal body harnesses. Follow OSHA guidelines. Slip resistance may vary with surface conditions from debris that accumulates, weather, footwear and roof pitch. Failure to use proper safety gear can result in serious injury. Depending on roof pitch and surface conditions, blocking may be required to support materials on the roof and is good safety practice. Remember to seal the nail holes after removing blocking.

Color&Style

Expert Advice By Patricia Verlodt

“Color & style go hand in hand when considering what shingle to use on your roof”

The color and style of your shingle are important! After all, your roof represents up to 40% of your home’s curb appeal, so it will always have a big impact on your home’s overall look.

When you look at home exterior color trends, you’ll notice that they’re typically much more muted than the color trends you see in fashion; for example, if bold greens are in the fashion magazines, you might see the introduction of new home exterior palettes in warm, earthy green tones. Why? Because bold green might not be “in” two years from now (likely not), but you will still have the same roof. Color choices in exteriors are long-term decisions, so make sure the palette that you select is not only one that fits your personality and taste today but also one that you’ll enjoy ten years down the road.

- Observe how much of your roof is visible from the street or common view. A larger roof looks best in neutral tones. If the roof angle is normal or slight, you can use more colorful shingles or interesting patterns.
- Use colors in the same color family as the body of your house for a simple, non-accented combination. An example is a gray roof on a gray house, whether light or dark gray. Trim in white or black will keep it understated.
- Use bright colors to make a design statement. For example, a green roof on a red brick house or a red roof on a gray house.
- And remember, follow your instinct. Choose the color and style that make you comfortable. After all, you’re the one looking at it every time you come home!

When it comes to the style of your shingle, it’s important to think about the overall look and shape of your home. If your roof has a low pitch, the shingle profile will be more important than the shape; for a roof with a steep pitch, a unique design or color pattern may be more important. If you have a large roof surface, you don’t want the color pattern of your shingle to be too busy (it can be overwhelming!). On the other hand, a larger surface gives you a great opportunity to really change your home’s look. So, make sure the design and color you select integrate extremely well with the rest of your house.

- Choose a shingle that complements your home’s architectural style. For example, for a Colonial home, select a shingle with a clean line that complements the home’s design. A Victorian house could take on a more colorful or complex design.
- The use of colors and textures can create a comfortable feel for your residence. For example, if focusing on the exterior of a Shingle Style home, adding color and textured design elements make the home much more approachable.

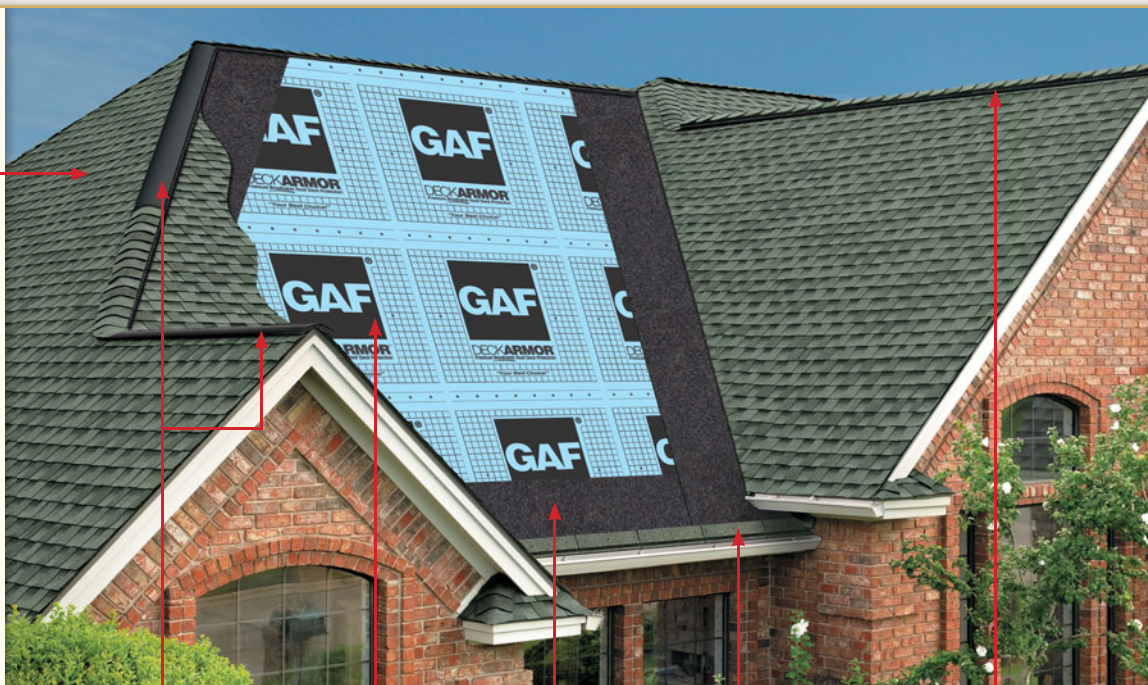

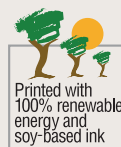
