This letter is from Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ. (1 Peter 1:1)

A) Brief Biography

A.1) A "blue collar" family man (Acts 4:13)

A.2) A pre-eminent Apostle of Jesus Christ (Matt 16:17-18)

There is no record of anyone being named Peter before Jesus invented this name for Simon.

Peter was no pope, but a pre-eminent Apostle (Rev 21:14).

Peter was the author of the Gospel of Mark

B) Lessons from the Life of Peter

B.1) From Coward to Courage by the Spirit of God

Denied Christ 3 times in the Gospels (Matt 26:74-75). Fearlessly preached Christ in Acts (5:27-42).

B.2) An Apostle by the Grace of God

Peter the Apostle sinned again in Antioch because of his fear of man (Gal 2:11-13)
