Permissive Will & Decision Making

Genesis 2:6-7

(Gen 2:16-17) **“You may freely eat the fruit of every tree in the garden-except the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. If you eat its fruit, you are sure to die.”**

Primary Point: God’s will for your life is: 1) Obey Scripture, 2) Pursue your desires, and 3) Make reasonable decisions.

The Permissive Will of God

The Wills of God in Your Most Important Decision (1 Corinthians 7)

More Mistakes in Mysticism

Mysticism wants to limit the permissive will of God.

Mysticism wants God to micromanage our lives.

Mysticism makes us doubt our desires.

Mysticism devalues the place of reason and logic in making good decisions.

Prov 3:5-6; 1 Kgs 2:2-3; Psalm 32:8; 1 Cor 2:15

Mysticism decreases the value of getting counsel

Mysticism devalues your God-given responsibility to make decisions (2 Tim 2:15)

Mysticism devalues the power of God to bless your life
