Primary Point: Christ is glorified through His love for us which saved us from God's wrath and made us servants of God.

1) Christ loved us by paying for our sins and rescuing us from the wrath of God

(Revelation 13:8; 14:9-11)

2) Christ loved us by making us servants of God

The priesthood of all believers means that all Christians are equal before God and have equal access to God, and are equally called to serve God.

(1 Timothy 2:5; Hebrews 4:16; 10:22; Matthew 23:7-9; Colossians 3:23-24)
