But although being a "know-it-all" makes us feel important, what is really needed to build the church is love

Primary Point: We must love people by respecting their conscience

Define Love: Understand where people are at, accept them and help them take a next step

1. UNDERSTAND THEIR CONSCIENCE

- A. Realize I don't know everything (v. 2)
- B. Good understanding produces favor (Prov 13:15)
- C. Be quick to listen (James 1:19)

2. ACCEPT THEIR CONSCIENCE

- A. Realize there is a reason others think differently than you (v. 7)
- B. Use my freedom wisely (v. 9)
- C. Let them be fully convinced (Rom 14:5)

3. HELP THEIR CONSCIENCE

- A. Don't force my conscience on others (v. 12)
- B. Be willing to adapt my conscience for the sake of others (v. 13)
- C. Remember the golden rule (Luke 6:31)
