The Glory of Christ in the Revelation #21 Our Appreciation for Being Rescued from Wrath

Revelation 6:12-17

- The wrath of God on Earth occurs after the Great Persecution, Rescue of the Church, and visible Return of Christ (Rev 6:1-17; Matt 24:29-31)
- A description of God's wrath in Revelation begins in chapter 8. (Rev 8:6-9:21)
- And what would essentially follow this period of God's wrath and punishment of the Earth, is the 1000 year kingdom of Christ on Earth.
- Throughout the OT Prophets, this period of God's Endtime wrath to punish people living on the Earth, was predicted and described many times as "The Day of the Lord." (Isaiah 13:9-13)

- 2) Be thankful that justice will be done to unbelievers (Rom 12:19)
