Openness (Heb 5:7; 1 Pet 5:7)

Word (Josh 1:8-9; Ps 119:11; Eph 6:16-17; John 8:32; Ps 42:5)

Entreaties (Ps 5:3)

Resolutions (Jas 1:22, 25)
