### **Understanding biblical fellowship**

- Biblical fellowship is living for Christ with your best friends. (Acts 2:42-46)
- This is necessary to obey the over 50 "one another" commands in the NT.

# **Authentic Christianity vs. American Christianity**

- The absence of close friendships in our local churches is one of the biggest differences between American Christianity and the Authentic Christianity of the first Christians. (John 13:34 NIV).
- You cannot, you will not, do biblical Christianity without the power of the Holy Spirit.
- It is important to understand that God wants you to have friendships beyond your family.
- God made Authentic Christianity a team sport.

## Why pursue biblical fellowship?

- A vital part of God's plan for your spiritual growth is best friends in your local church who are pursuing the "one another" commands with you. (1 Thess 5:11; Heb 3:13; Prov 13:20).
- God knows how to change your life, and He says you cannot do it alone. Loving people and sharing your life with others has its risks.
- -Sharing your life with others encourages you to be HUMBLE. (1 Pet 5:5-6).
