It can change your life no matter what

Philippians 4:4

Remember Paul's chains.

“Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!” (Phil 4:4)

Primary point: The power of praise can change your life no matter what.

The power of praise protects our hearts (Phil 4:6-7)

The painful hardships and losses in our life can make us better or bitter. (Rom 1:21-23)

This world is a very dangerous and painful place to live if you are not constantly praising God. (Ps 103:1-2)

How do you praise God no matter what?

“Rejoice in the Lord always” (Phil 4:4; Luke 10:20; Phil 4:8; 1 Thess 5:16-18; 2 Cor 6:9-10).

The power of praise to give us joy (Ps 89:15-16)

The power of praise to give God joy (Psalm 50:23; Luke 17:11-18; Phil 2:14; Job 1:20-22)

Start your day & week with praising Go (Ps 100:4; 92:1; 109:30).
