Habit #6: The Power of Entreaties I

This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him. (1 John 5:14-15 NIV)

God gives you a lot of power when you pray in a biblical way.

The power of prayer (Matt 19:24-26; 21:21; Josh 10:12-13; James 5:16-17).

"You do not have because you do not ask God" (James 4:2).

Believe in the goodness of God (Ps 62:11-12; Matt 7:9-11).

The power of praying according to the known will of God (John 15:7, 16).
