Why? To not receive correction is like a cow (Prov 12:1)

It is a way of life (Prov 6:23)

It demonstrates love (Lev 19:17)

What? Sin (Matt 18:15)

Wisdom (Acts 18:24-26) Character (Eph 4:15)

Preferences - suggest; don't demand

Who? Not the foolish (Prov 23:9)

A person that welcomes correction (Prov 9:8) Someone that you are trying to love (Matt 22:39)

When? After you take the log out of your eye (Matt 7:3)

At a "wise" time (Prov 15:2)

If you are avoiding a person or unable to think well of

another person

When God shows you a need, you are most likely part of the solution

Where? In private (Matt 18:15)

How? Use verses to point out the reproof and the correction

(2 Tim 3:16-17)

With wisdom. Do not gossip. Get help if needed. Tone.

(Prov 15:2)

How do you want to be corrected? (Lk 6:31, Prov 25:11-12)
