A) The Proof & Promise of God's Love: Eternal

happiness at the expense of His Son

- God the Father gave us God the Son to die for us so that He could also give us an eternal happy life.
- God wants to share His future happiness with us. (Matt 25:21).
- God wants to give us even Himself. (John 17:1-20)

B) The Challenges of Believing God's Love: "In this world you will have trouble"

1) Do not doubt God's love because of pain in the world (1 Pet 1:3-8)

When God makes everything perfect, we will gain a lot. But we will also lose something that is precious . . . the opportunity to glorify God with our faith.

2) Do not doubt God's love because of threatened needs you have in the world

Because God loves us, He has not only promised to take care of us on the new Earth, but also while we live on this old one. (Heb 13:5-6; Luke 12:32-33)

3) Do not doubt God's love because of withheld desires you have in this world

- Not even God gets all that He wants from this world right now.
- Nothing that you desire will fulfill you more than what God has already given you.
- If God gave you what you desire—and He might—it would only be a short time after that you would want something else. (Prov 27:20)
- We cannot make the granting of our desires a measure of God's love for us. Jesus dying on the cross to give us eternal happiness is how much God loves us.
