A) American Evangelism

- Definition: Believing we have the ability and responsibility to convince people of sin and salvation.
- Cost: *false conversions*
- *Unbiblical burdens of American evangelism*

B) Biblical Evangelism

- *Spiritually dead people cannot believe* (John 6:44, 63, 65; 1 Cor 2:14)
- *The Spirit convicts people of sin* (John 16:7-8; Mark 10:17; Acts 16:30)
- The Spirit prepares people for the Gospel (2 Cor 4:3-6; Acts 16:14; Eph 2:1, 4-5, 8)
