#3: Chosen Unconditionally by the Grace of God Romans 11:5-6

A) The Expanding Scope of God's Plan of Salvation

From one nation to all nations

- For 2000 years of human history, since the time of Abraham, essentially only Jews were saved. (Deut 7:6-8; Matt 10:5-6; 15:24; Acts 11:18).
- With the implementation of God's New Covenant He expanded the parameters of salvation (Rev 5:9; Matt 28:19).
- The remnant chosen by grace for salvation is small (Matt 7:13-14; 22:14).

B) Dealing with Misconceptions of God's Plan of Salvation

- 1) Pluralism (all religions can save) (John 14:6).
- 2) Armenianism (fairism)
- 3) Fideism (faith in contradiction) (John 3:16, 18, 36)
- 4) Hyper-Calvinism (no need to evangelize)
 - Gracism does not discourage evangelism- but encourages it. (Eph 1:4-5,11; John 6:37; Acts 13:45; 2 Tim 2:10; 1 Cor 1:22; 2 Cor 2:15-16)
