(v. 2) Its Responsibility: preach the Word accurately (Eph 4:7, 11) (vs. 2-4) Its Reasons: correction, encouragement, & protection (vs. 1 & 5) Its Accountability: evaluation by the Author (2 Tim 2:15; Jms 3:1)
