III. Parable of the Lost Son

- The Sinful Son (younger)
 - 1. Shocking request (v.12)
- The Sacrificial Father
 - 1. Selfless act (v. 12)
- The Selfish Son (older)
 - 1. Silent (v.12)
- The Sinful Son (younger)
 - 1. Shattered his relationship with his father and the community (v.12-13)
 - 2. Spent all his money on worldly goods. (v.14)
 - 3. Starving for food (v. 14-16)
 - 4. Said to himself, "Father, please take me on as a hired servant. (v.17-19)

• The Sacrificial Father

- 1. Shamed himself to protect his son. (v.20)
- 2. Sends his servants to bring robes, rings and sandals for his feet. (v. 22)
- 3. Selects the fattened calf to be killed for a celebration feast. (v.24)
- The Selfish Son (older son)
 - 1. Shameful act (v.28)
 - 2. Sees himself as a slave not a son. (v.29)
 - 3. Shattered relationship with his father and his brother. (v.30)

• The Sacrificial Father

- 1. Shows great compassion for the older son. (v.30)
- 2. Salvation for the lost is worth celebrating! (v. 31)
