A) God's expectations in charity: Radical generosity

B) God's priorities in charity: Needy and godly Christians

First is your family (1 Tim 5:3-4, 8)

Second is your church family. (Gal 6:10)

Not all poor and needy people are worthy of our generosity. (2 Thess 3:10; 1 Tim 5:3, 9-10)

C) God's purposes for charity: Gratitude, testimony, & reward

Matt 25:34-40; John 13:34-35; Gal 6:10; 1 Cor 11:20-22; Luke 12:33; 18:22; Prov 19:17
