Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen!

#### **Two points to remember...**

1. Without God's revelation of his eternity, immortality, and invisibleness, we would be without hope.
2. Honor and glory forever and ever includes this very hour.

#### **It's all a matter of God's revelation**

- Ephesians 1:15-17 For this reason I too .... do not cease giving thanks for you, while making mention of you in my prayers; that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him.
- Ephesians 2:8-9 For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.
- Without God's revelation of his eternity, immortality, and invisibleness, we would be without hope.

#### **Honor and glory forever and ever includes this very hour**

- Let's not make the mistake that honor and glory forever and ever applies to some other time. Forever and ever includes this very hour!
- Have you ever?
- Have you ever said to God – let me do this one thing and I won't do it ever again? God, just turn your gaze, or close your ear for just a few minutes, and then you can have me back. I will give you my all ... later. Tomorrow. Next year. Before I die. Just wait a minute!
- The eternal, immortal, invisible, sole God of everything deserves our honor and glory in this very second, minute, hour, day, year, decade, generation, and lifetime!

#### **A prisoner**

- Six times Paul refers to himself as a "prisoner" of Christ. What does this mean to you?
- Ephesians 4:1 Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called!
