## How "Social" is the Gospel?

Primary Point: The Social Gospel movement is a dangerous threat to the Gospel of the Bible.

**Primary Text:** John 6:1-15; 25-35

Definition of the "Social Gospel": A person must not only be converted but also labor for economic and social equality among all people groups.

- 1. The Social Gospel is legalism.
- 2. The Social Gospel has the same heart as the health and wealth Gospel.
- 3. The Social Gospel keeps people focused on their victim status, and thus stops them from receiving Christ.

Jesus did not come here to change our circumstances; He came here to empower us to live ABOVE our circumstances.
