EXTENSION OF TIME TO SUBMIT PROPOSALS
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR LEGAL SERVICES

The New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority ("NJSEA") issued a Request for Proposal for Legal Services on December 11, 2015 ("RFP").

NJSEA qualified a set of firms to provide legal services to the Authority based on submissions received in response to the RFP.

By this notice, NJSEA is soliciting additional responses to this RFP, is extending the deadline to submit responses, and will evaluate and may qualify additional firms from responses received.

THEREFORE PLEASE BE ADVISED that the deadline to submit Proposals has been extended to Friday, February 12, 2016.

Proposals will be received at the above address until 2:00 p.m., prevailing time, on February 12, 2016. Proposals will not be accepted after the above time and date.

The RFP documents are available for download from our website [at this link](#) under the original date of issue or may be picked up at the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority offices at One DeKorte Park Plaza, Lyndhurst, NJ between 9:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. on weekdays.

In accordance with Public Law 2004, c.57, the NJSEA may only enter into contracts with entities who provide proof of valid business registration with the Division of Revenue in the Department of Treasury, of the State of New Jersey. Such proof must be submitted concurrently with the proposal.

In order to insulate the award of state contracts from risk of improper influence, the NJSEA shall only enter into a Contract with an entity who complies with Public Law 2005, C.51 and Executive Order 117. The required forms and instructions are included in the RFP.

NJSEA reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and, so far as permitted by law, to waive any irregularity or informality with respect to any proposal. The NJSEA further reserves the right to make such investigations as it deems necessary as to the qualifications of any and all firms submitting proposals. In the event that all proposals are rejected, the NJSEA reserves the right to re-solicit proposals.
